Pandemic Delivery Service – self isolating  Continues until 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2021	The delivery service continues for those patients that need to self-isolate. Patients will need to provide their Track & Trace ID reference number as proof of eligibility. More information on the PSNC website	
Pharmacy Collect c-19 Test Distribution Service – Data recording	Data for this service should be recorded on MYS before the close of play on the last trading day of each week.  More information available <a href="here">here</a> .	
May Bank Holiday opening times reminder	You are required to notify your patients of the nearest pharmacies open to your pharmacy on the Bank holiday dates if you are closed. Details available on the LPC website.	
Steroid Emergency Card 13 <sup>th</sup> May 2021	Community pharmacies should ensure they can source and supply Steroid Emergency Cards to replace those lost by patients or which become damaged. MYS Access	The period of time in which contractors can access MYS using Smartcards has been extended to Sunday 16 <sup>th</sup> May 2021.	
Smartcard access to MYS portal now ending on Sunday 16 <sup>th</sup> May 2021	Smartcard users must register to access the MYS Portal using NHSMail login credentials before 11:59 pm on Sunday 16 <sup>th</sup> May, after which access to the MYS portal using Smartcards will be withdrawn.	
	To register for MYS access using NHSMail you must download and complete the form on the <a href="https://www.NHSBSA.website">NHSBSA.website</a> and send it to nhsbsa.mys@nhs.net	
Pharmacy Quality Scheme (PQS) Part 2  30 <sup>th</sup> June 2021	The declaration period for PQS ended on the 1 <sup>st</sup> March 2021. However, pharmacy contractors have been given flexibility until the 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2021 to collate the evidence to demonstrate that they are compliant with the requirements of some domains.	
	Contractors are reminded to ensure any domains they have claimed for, yet still need to fulfil the criteria, to do so before the June deadline otherwise the NHSBSA will reclaim PQS payments.
