When a patient finishes their initial cancer treatment they will be given a copy of their 'End of Treatment Summary' which will include their diagnosis, treatment and ongoing treatment plan. There will be information on how they can re contact hospital teams. They can share their End of Treatment summary with their local pharmacist.
