CPPE Training

CPPE have developed a suite of resources, including a self-assessment, to support the implementation of the Pharmacy First service; they are also delivering face to face training sessions, look out for future dates.

VirtualOutcomes

Pharmacies in Devon have free access to VirtualOutcomes. They have developed a series of modules to support Pharmacy First including one module for each clinical pathway, an introduction and overview module for the pharmacy team and one for general practice teams. Access the training here.

Agilio Training

To support the rollout of the NHS Pharmacy First Service, Agilio have developed a series of free elearning courses.

These courses are based on NICE CKS and are aligned to the NHS England clinical pathways and PGDs.

They include a case study and multiple-choice questions to test understanding, with a certificate of completion.
