Pharmacy First Service Income July 2024	<p>The activity threshold of clinical pathway consultations remains at 10 per month for July. This means you have to provide a minimum of 10 consultations that pass the gateway point to be eligible for the £1,000 monthly payment.</p>	
Pharmacy First By the 5th of the month	<p>Remember to claim every month for service activity via MYS.</p>

PharmOutcomes Access Access regularly	<p>Check that pharmacy staff have access to PharmOutcomes during all opening times, especially when locums are on duty; set-up additional accounts if needed. PharmOutcomes must be checked regularly throughout the day and referrals and messages received actioned.</p>	
Community Pharmacy Devon Mailing List	Encourage locums and the rest of your pharmacy team to join the LPC mailing list to ensure they are up to date with changes. Visit our website or see below for sign up.
