She has recently been appointed as the Head of the new MPharm degree in Plymouth where the Bath MPharm is now also being delivered, bringing a new School of Pharmacy to the South West. Lyn has taught at undergraduate and postgraduate levels with experience in delivering MPharm, Pre-registration (Foundation), Diploma and Independent Prescribing programmes. Lyn's research interests focus on the development of skills and competence for the pharmacy workforce and in particular the role of Entrustable Professional Activities (EPAs) to support pharmacy students during experiential learning. She has recently led a steering group to develop EPAs for use in MPharm degrees in England.



Danielle Wigg is a highly experienced pharmacist, educator, post-graduate researcher and presenter. As the Pharmacy Foundation Training Lead for the NHS England Workforce Training & Education (WT&E) South West Pharmacy Team she will be exploring opportunities for workforce development in the South West, as well as a call to action to develop the workforce to meet the needs of the future.
