Training course

As you may be aware, following a procurement process by NHS England, the training course offer for 2025/26 trainees will be provided by PWDS (PWDS – Pharmacy Workforce Development South) It is compulsory for all foundation trainee pharmacists, regardless of sector, entering the programme in 2025 to attend the mandatory core training. The training course content will include professionalism, developing as a culturally competent practitioner, clinical reasoning and decision making, leadership development, first aid and developing as a prescriber.
