<b>Pharmacy First</b>	Updated Pharmacy First caps come into force in June 2025. Check your monthly cap <a href="#">here</a> Ask your patients to give feedback on Pharmacy First to help inform service improvements. Find out more <a href="#">here</a>	
<b>Community pharmacy assurance framework (CPAF) screening questionnaire</b>  <b>1<sup>st</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2025</b>	Pharmacy contractors will shortly receive confirmation from NHS BSA that the CPAF screening questionnaire will go live on 1 July 2025 and will be available for completion until midnight on 31 July.  Users of NHS BSA's Manage Your Service (MYS) portal will be able to complete this year's CPAF by logging in. The small number of contractors who do not have a sign-in for MYS will be able to complete the questionnaire online and will receive an email setting out details on how to do this.  Completion of the screening questionnaire is compulsory. The results will be used to determine which contractors receive a monitoring visit and who will be asked to complete the full CPAF survey. <b>Vaccine IT System</b>	NHS England has announced the launch of a new Point of Care (PoC) IT Supplier Contractual Framework, allowing pharmacy owners to choose which system they use to make their clinical records for the Flu and COVID-19 vaccination services during the 2025/26 campaign. ▪ Find out more <a href="#">here</a>	
<b>Amendments to core opening hours regulations.</b>  <b>In place from 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2025</b>	Key Change: A new application route (Regulation 26(2ZB)) introduced, allowing pharmacy owners greater flexibility to apply to change core opening hours, provided the change better meets patient and user needs ▪ Find out more <a href="#">here</a> .  This change offers pharmacy owners more control over operational hours, aligning services more closely with community requirements.	
<b>Contraception and Sexual Health Update Event</b>  <b>15<sup>th</sup> July 2025</b>	For North Devon pharmacy teams, a sexual health training session is being held for pharmacists to discussion emergency hormonal contraception, chlamydia screening, Progesterone only pill (POP), Combined Pill (COC) and talking with young people training session. <b>PharmOutcomes Access</b>	Check that pharmacy staff have access to PharmOutcomes during all opening times, <b>especially when locums are on duty</b> ; set-up additional accounts if needed. PharmOutcomes <b>must</b> be checked regularly throughout the day and referrals and messages received actioned.	
<b>Community Pharmacy Devon Mailing List</b>	Encourage locums and the rest of your pharmacy team to join our mailing list to ensure they are up to date with changes. Visit our <a href="#">website</a> or see below for sign up.
