Flu vaccination services. (Adult) 1st September 2026	Pregnant women only can start to be vaccinated under the 2026-27 Service (other eligible patients cannot be vaccinated until 1 st October 2026).	
PQS PEoLC 27th August – 31st December 2026	The Palliative and End of Life Care questionnaire (PEoLC) will be published on the NHSBSA website. Pharmacy Owners must complete this by the end of 31 st December 2026. This is a requirement of the gateway criterion.	
PQS Clinical Services Audit 31st March 2027	The Clinical Services Audit has been published on the NHSBSA website. Download the PQS 2026-27 clinical services audit – Pharmacy First Clinical pathways consultations	
Pharmacy First September 2026	Updated Pharmacy First caps come into force for September 2026 • Check NHSBSA website to see what your cap is for this month.	
Mandatory CPCF Health Campaign 5th October – 25th October 2026	The first national health campaign is focusing on the expectation that pharmacy staff are treated with respect. The campaign intends to support the findings of the recent CPE poll and will run from Monday 5 th October until Sunday 25 th October. Pharmacy owners are required to take part in this health campaign as it is part of the Community Pharmacy Contractual Framework 2026-27. Hypertension Case Finding Service 3rd September 2026	New changes to the Hypertension Case-Finding Service come into effect. Read the update, new specification and updated FAQs here .	
Directory of Services (DoS) 30th September 2026	If you haven't already done so, update your NHS Website profile and DoS profile by the 30 September 2026 using NHS profile Manager . MUST DO: Update with Flu, COVID as appropriate and verify all five sections. This is a mandatory requirement for all pharmacy owners

Training	Local training events Needle provision and removing stigma online training event 16th September Contraception and sexual health update 24th September	
PharmOutcomes Access	Check that pharmacy staff have access to PharmOutcomes during all opening times, especially when locums are on duty ; set-up additional accounts if needed. PharmOutcomes must be checked regularly throughout the day and referrals and messages received actioned.	
EPS Nomination Principles	Community pharmacy teams are reminded of the importance of always aligning with the EPS nomination principles and upholding patient choice. • Find out more here • Read the one-page fact sheet of the four guiding principles of patient nomination here	
Community Pharmacy Devon Mailing List	Encourage locums and the rest of your pharmacy team to join our mailing list to ensure they are up to date with changes. Visit our website or see below for sign up. Sometimes (why?) emails from CP Devon go into the NHS Spam Filters. Please check for this otherwise you might miss out on important information!
